#### Birds

- We had a birds nest in the science area

- We made binoculars
- We are going to make bird feed and hang it during Forest Friday
- The RSPC tweeted us to tell us about their resources which we have used to identify birds, bugs and plants.

#### Bugs

- We have been reading 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and setting up lots of activities relating to this book
- We had caterpillars which are now turning into butterflies – this is helping us to learn about life cycles
- We have been digging in the garden to find insects and looking at them with science resources
- We had toy insects and natural resources in our Tuff Tray
- We made insects at the craft table
