## Literacy

Literacy Learning updates for your class for the term.

Primary 5/6 will develop summarising and paraphrasing skills to reflect their knowledge of what has been read.

To fit in with our Japan topic, Primary 5/6 will be reading 'Grenade' which is set around Japan during WWII.

In writing, we will be developing narrative writing skills, focusing on plot detail and adding a plot twist. We will also be creating detailed, factual reports.
