Literacy

This term we have been developing our summarising skills in reading lessons making sure to include all the main points from the text. Next, we will be re-visiting paraphrasing.

We are currently reading fiction novels and stories in our reading groups and complete comprehension tasks linked to these. As a class we will be moving on to a book linked to our Australia Topic called My Story Australia.

In writing, we are currently developing our skills for narratives. We are focusing on features such as setting and characterisation to create interesting stories.

Numeracy

In maths, the current topic is Shape, specifically Angles. We have been learning the different sizes and types of angles, how to estimate and measure angles with a protractor. We have drawn angles moving on to drawing angles with a given degrees and figuring out missing angles in different types of triangles. Next, we are moving on to 2d and 3d shape and will be focusing on identifying them and recognising their features.

Big Maths will continue to develop general numeracy skills with the Beat That timed multiplication assessment on Friday morning.

We are continuing the acronym RUCSAC and have a problem solving lesson once a week with Miss Morrison.
