#### Writing:

This term, Primary 4/5 will be writing recounts, sharing their experiences and how they made us feel.

#### Reading:

We will be reading daily during ERIC time to develop fluency and enjoyment. Comprehension skills will be developed throughout term, using evidence from the text to justify our answers.

#### Listening & Talking:

We will be developing listening and discussion skills.

#### Rounding:

Primary 4/5 will develop rounding and estimation skills. We will round a range of numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1000 & whole number. Using these skills, we will begin to provide estimated answers.

#### Measurement:

This term we will also develop measuring skills. Primary 4/5 will learn to convert between different units of measurement, to measure accurately and to choose appropriate units of measurement.
